



POSITION: KITCHEN PORTER / DISHWASHER

Job Overview: The Kitchen Porter performs a number of kitchen activities including pot washing, dish washing, general cleaning duties and storing food and non-food supplies.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Wash dishes, utensils, and pots.
- Operate dish washing equipment.
- Distribute and store clean pots, dishes and utensils.
- Clean and sanitize production equipment, work surfaces and kitchen according to cleaning schedules and procedures.
- Empty trash containers as required.
- Maintain assigned work station in a safe and sanitary condition.
- Maintain acceptable standards of personal hygiene and complies with department dress code.
- Follow safety regulations; report injuries or any unsafe conditions and work practices to the supervisor.
- Attend in-service training and education sessions as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to follow verbal instructions in English.
- Previous experience preferred but not required. Will train on the job.
- Fundamental understanding of sanitation, cleanliness and personal hygiene.
- Food Handler’s card required.
- Regular, predictable and reliable attendance.

Physical Demands

- Exposure to bloodborne pathogens: Level III.
- Requires moderate physical effort. Standing, carrying, bending, stretching, stooping, pulling and pushing, lifting of weights up to 50 pounds.

Working Conditions

- Working conditions involve noise, heat, temperature changes, kitchen elements, odors, moisture, etc.
- May be required to work additional hours as dictated by the work load and staffing.
- Must be willing to work evenings, weekends and holidays.
